The Year of the Nurse

The World Health Assembly, the governing body of the World Health Organization (WHO), designated **2020** as the **International Year of the Nurse** and Midwife to advance **nurses**' vital position in transforming healthcare around the world. <u>It also is in honor of the 200th</u> anniversary of Florence Nightingale's birth.

WHO is leading the development of the first-ever State of the World's Nursing report which will be launched in 2020, prior to the 73rd World Health Assembly. The report will describe the nursing workforce in WHO Member States, providing an assessment of "fitness for purpose" relative to targets. WHO is also a partner on The State of the World's Midwifery 2020 report, which will also be launched around the same time.


